The Certificate of Graduate Study in Public Health provides post-baccalaureate students with an opportunity to broaden their understanding of public health, supplement another degree, enhance their current professional or clinical skills, or prepare for further graduate study. This program may be of interest to non-degree seeking professionals who have completed an undergraduate degree in a related discipline and want to demonstrate content competence in public health. The certificate is also helpful for current graduate students in other disciplines who want to complement their existing graduate study with essential public health knowledge. Students can begin the Certificate of Graduate Study in Public Health in the fall and can complete the Certificate program in two semesters (fall and spring).

WHY A CERTIFICATE IN PUBLIC HEALTH?

- The foundational public health courses required for the Certificate program align with Council on Education for Public Health (CEPH) accredited MPH programs.
- · Comprised of core foundational public health graduate courses, certificate courses can be easily transferred into the NCWU MPH program and should transfer into most MPH programs.
- Expand your current professional skills or specialize in a public health-related area
- · Enhance your current graduate program and increase your post-graduate marketability

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA:

- An undergraduate degree No prerequisite. A strong interest in, or background/education in public health or a related field is encouraged.
- Must submit official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended, demonstrating successful or pending completion of a baccalaureate degree from an accredited institution
- Minimum undergraduate 2.7 overall GPA
- Complete our FREE application

Note: Certificate programs are separate from master's programs, however, certificate credits can be applied to a master's program.
