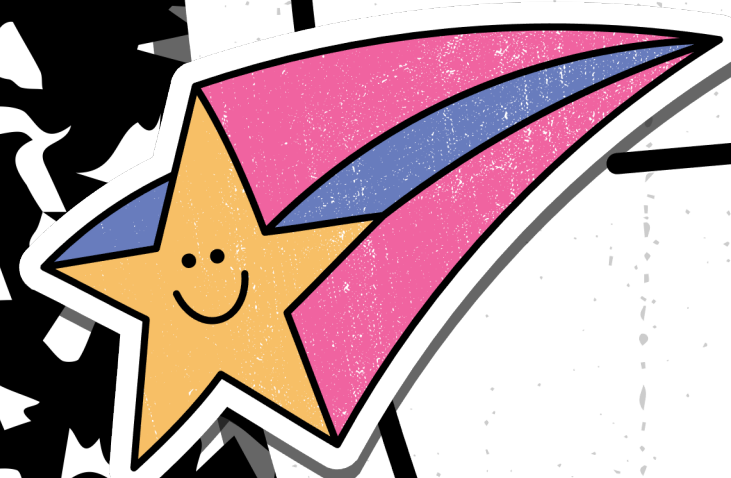

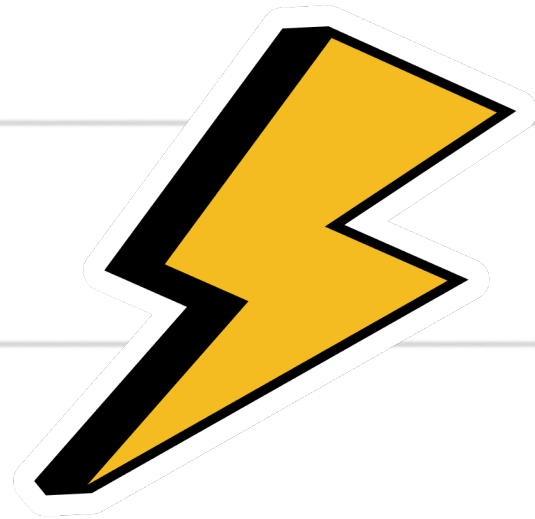

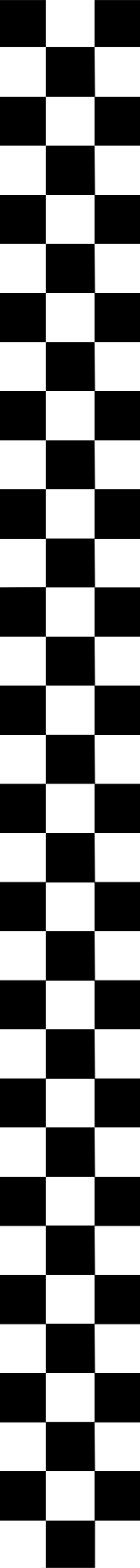
The Student Success Center

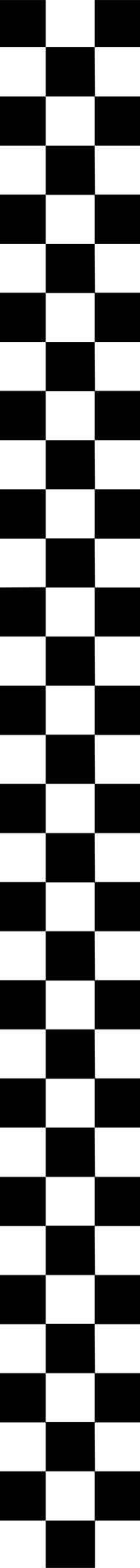
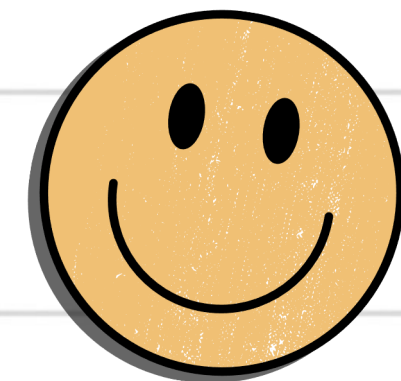
Wesleyan Transition

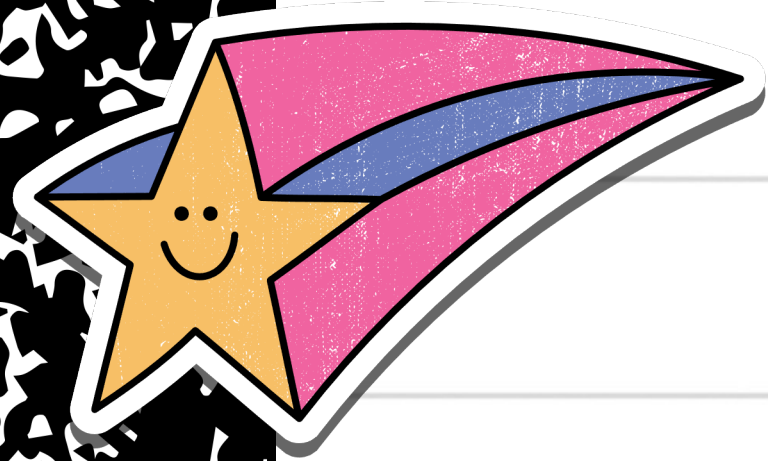
- COL 103 is required for all new students!
- Wesleyan Core Requirement



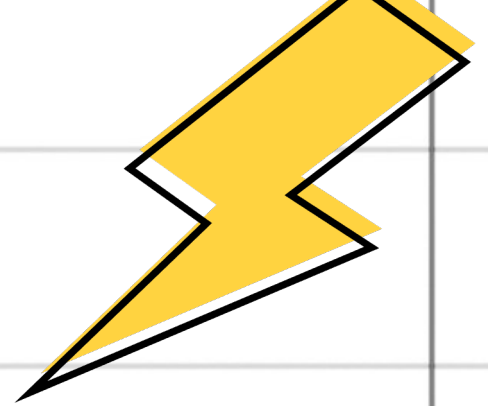
- One credit hour, meets once per week
- Taught by advisor, with First Year Mentor
- Interactive and discussion based
- Focus on success in college and campus engagement

- Transfer students take COL 103 online.





The Wesleyan Core ***(General Ed. Requirements)***



- **A copy of The Core is in your folder! Read the mission statement.**
- **General education courses are required for your degree, no matter what your major is (BS and BA).**
- **You must take general (Core) courses every semester.**
- **Your academic advisor made your schedule for this semester and will assist you in future planning.**
- **You will take more general education courses in your first year than requirements for your major.**
- **Most are introductory level courses and are likely not related to your major.**
- **Some of these courses may help you determine a major if you are still undeclared.**

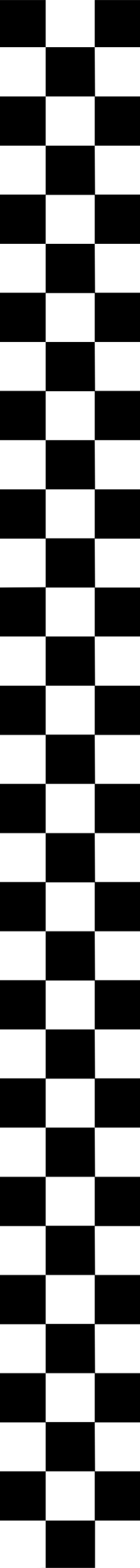
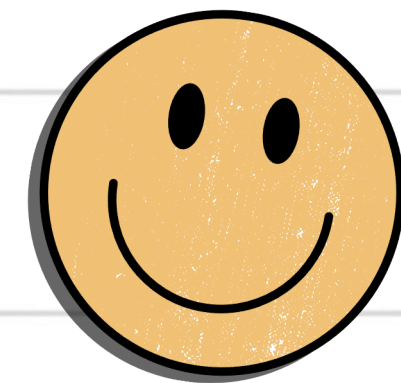
Major Requirements

- Every major has a list of requirements that you must complete to earn the degree.
- These courses are always available to view in the catalog. See your QR code sheet!



- What if you do not have a major yet? That's okay! You will take different Core courses and explore majors in COL 103.

- If you are ready to declare your major, OR you see that your listed major is incorrect, use the QR code sheet to go to the major/minor declaration form and correct that now!

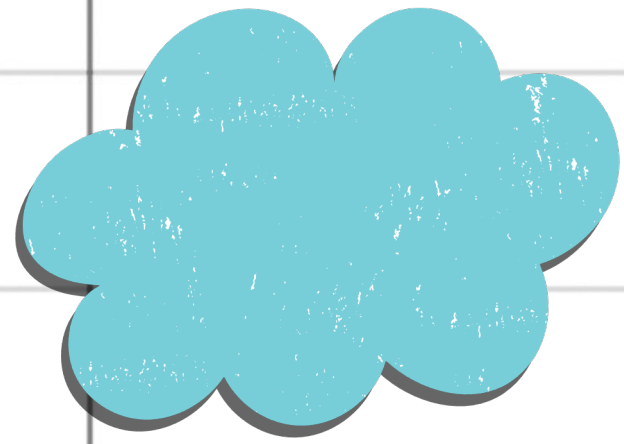




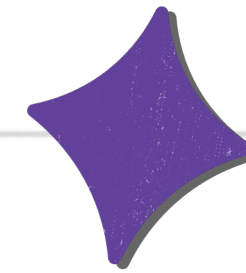

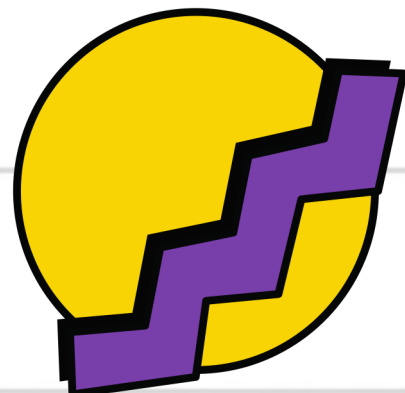

Early Alerts



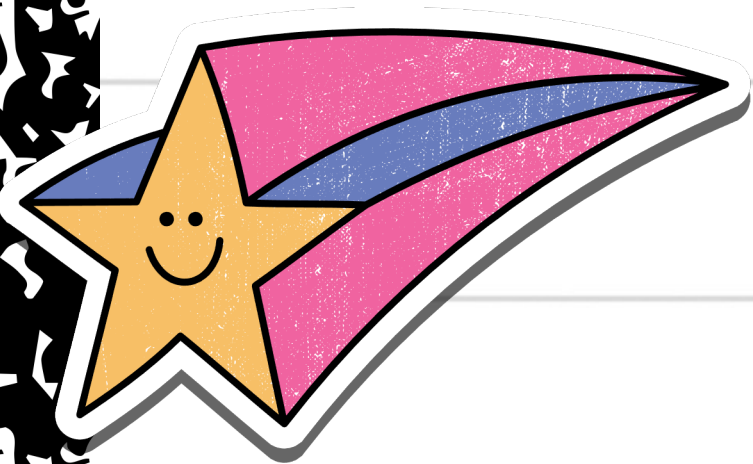
- **NCWU uses an early alert system to help students stay on track and be successful.**
- **Throughout the semester, if you struggle with attendance, start failing a class, seem to be overwhelmed, need the support of a tutor, or any other concern, your professors, coaches and advisors will be alerted.**
- **The SSC monitors that system and may reach out to you to follow up on what is going on and how to work through it.**
- **An early alert is not a bad thing. It's like a rumble strip on the highway-- alerting you to get back on the road to success!**



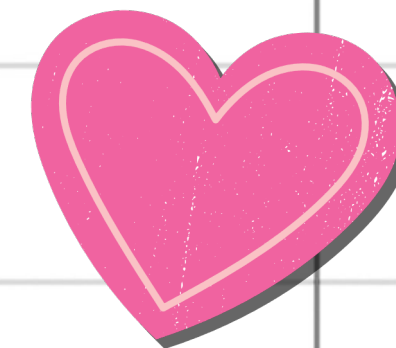
FERPA

(Family Educational Rights Privacy Act)

- **If you want someone other than yourself to have access to your academic records, tuition statements, and student records, you must fill out the FERPA form. This form permits a staff or faculty member to discuss your personal records to the people you indicate on the FERPA form.**
- **For example, if your father calls me and asks how you are doing in your courses, I cannot tell him unless you have given him permission on the FERPA form to disclose this information.**
- **If you do not fill out the FERPA form, this means that you are not giving anyone permission to view your student records.**
- **You can update this form at any time while you are a student.**
- **Use the QR Code page in your folder and fill the form out online.**
- **We will give you time to do this NOW!**

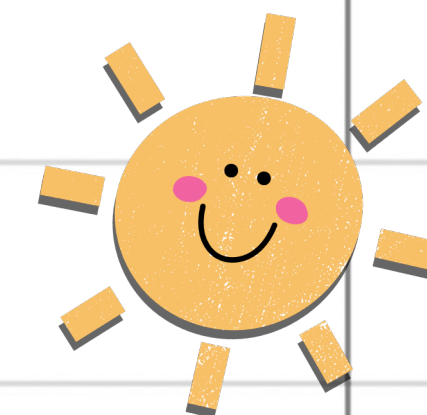
