Transfer Requirements

- **12 transferrable college credits** (course level typically 100 or above; must have at least a C in each course), students with fewer than 12 transferrable college credits must apply as a freshman.
- **GPA of 2.0 or higher**; demonstrate good standing with all post-secondary institutions attended.
- **Provide an official transcript** from each post-secondary institution attended.
- Students transferring with an AA/AS from the NC Community College System are considered to have met all general education requirements. For students transferring prior to receiving an AA/AS or from schools outside the NCCCS, transcripts will be evaluated on a course-by-course basis.

Financial Aid

- **100% of traditional students are eligible** to receive financial aid. Financial aid awards are based on your Admission information, enrollment classification, housing status and FAFSA information.
- **Complete your FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) and use school code **002951**.

- **2+ Wesleyan Scholarship - \$2,000**
Must have an associate degree with an overall GPA of 2.0 or higher
- **Phi Theta Kappa/Gamma Beta Phi Scholarship - \$1,000**
Must have an associate degree and proof of membership
- **United Methodist Scholarship - \$2,000**
Must be a member of the United Methodist Church and submit a letter of reference from pastor



Transfer scholarships are renewed annually, require full-time enrollment and a GPA of 2.0 or higher in college coursework. Additional scholarships and awards may be available. Please review the NCWU website for additional and updated scholarship information.
