ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

- Completed NCWU Graduate Application NOTE: International applicants must complete International Graduate Application.
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative undergraduate GPA: Applicants with a GPA below 2.5 may still be considered based on other application materials.
- Official Undergraduate Transcripts: Submit official transcripts from: undergraduate program, showing degree conferral and graduate coursework, if applicable. International Institutions will require a completed evaluation by approved evaluation agency.
- Resume with Two References: Include a current resume listing two professional or academic references. Letters of recommendation may be requested.
- Statement of Purpose: A written statement outlining your academic and professional goals.
- English Proficiency Exam Results (only if undergraduate degree is not from a US institution)
- NOTE: Some programs require specific requirements such as undergraduate coursework or related work experience.
