HOW IT WORKS

Format:

- Three courses each semester (7 sh)
- Year round program
- Each semester includes:
 - 16-week course (3 credits)
 - 8-week course (3 credits)
 - 16-week Internship (1 credit)

On Campus Experience

Each semester, students will participate in an intensive, concentrated residency weekend* as part of their coursework. With this unique **flexible course format**, students have the option to **live anywhere in the United States** and commute to NC Wesleyan University's campus for the required residency weekends.

Internship

The program features a 16-week Applied Learning Internship (1 credit), allowing students to implement the knowledge from their other coursework in real-world settings through work or internship opportunities. This internship **qualifies international students for CPT**.

TUITION & COST

Tuition** for Executive Residency Graduate Programs is **extremely competitive**.

- MBA- \$550 per credit hour (total of 35)
- MSITM- \$550 per credit hour (total of 32)
- MSSSL- \$550 per credit hour (total of 32)

Additional fees:

- Processing Fee: \$500 (applied to tuition)**
- Technology Fee: \$50 every 8-week session
- Books - varies by program
- Graduation Fee: \$125

Admissions Criteria for Domestic & International Students:

- NCWU Graduate Application
- Completed Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university, minimum GPA 2.5
Executive Residency Graduate Programs may require specific degree or equivalent work experience
- Official Undergraduate Transcripts
If not from a US institution, International Students will be required to pay for and submit an evaluated transcript from an approved agency.
- Resume with contact information for two references
- Statement of Purpose
- English Proficiency Exam Results (only if undergraduate degree is not from a US institution)
