General Graduation Guidelines:

- Total of 30 semester hours of MSSL coursework
- Completion of all MSSL coursework within five years of enrolling
- A cumulative GPA average of B (3.00)
- Minimum final grade of C in any course, no more than two grades of a C

- Evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of a crisis response

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA:

- An accredited undergraduate degree
- Resume with two references (must be able to provide reference letters upon request)
- Complete a statement of purpose
- Minimum undergraduate GPA of 2.5

Note: Graduate school applicants with a cumulative GPA below 2.5 may still be considered based upon other factors submitted in the application.
