PROGRAM STRUCTURE

In-person, 10 Week Format includes: Lectures, Hands-on Labs, Independent Practice, Journal Clubs
(Monday – Friday 8am – 5pm)

- **Weeks 1-2:** Lecture-focused instruction covering core concepts in reproductive biology
- **Weeks 3-10:** Primarily hands-on laboratory training in andrology and embryology techniques
- **Guest Lecturers:** Learn from industry experts and professionals in assisted reproductive technology
- **Weekly Exams & Assessments:** Hands-on competency evaluations (80% pass rate required on exams and assessments), 90% Attendance Requirement

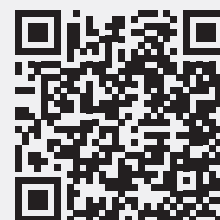
